Exception to Texas Governor Abbott's Executive Order GA-12 Regarding Travelers from Louisiana

EXEMPTION FOR CRITICAL INFRASTRUCTURE WORKERS

To Whom This May Concern:

Sasol Chemicals (USA) LLC (Sasol) is engaged in work necessary to the operations, maintenance and construction of a critical infrastructure sector as identified by the U.S. Department of Homeland Security. The Department of Homeland Security—identified as the Chemical Sector-Specific Agency (SSA) in Presidential Policy Directive (PPD) 21—leads the Chemical Sector's public-private partnership and works with companies to develop tools and resources that enhance the sector's security and resilience.

Sasol manufactures chemicals needed for the critical infrastructure of the United States. The Chemical Sector is an integral component of the U.S. economy that manufactures, stores, uses, and transports potentially dangerous chemicals upon which a wide range of other critical infrastructure sectors rely. Securing these chemicals against growing and evolving threats requires vigilance from both the private and public sector.

This letter is disseminated to employees of Sasol to demonstrate that this employee is an essential critical infrastructure worker at Sasol's Westlake, Louisiana site. It is also disseminated to contractors, construction workers and craftsman who are constructing critical infrastructure at Sasol's Westlake, Louisiana site.

It is critical for the community that Sasol's operations and construction continue. Therefore, Sasol respectfully requests that the employee bearing this letter, with proper identification, be allowed to proceed to or from his/her place of employment to ensure this critical infrastructure is not impacted.

This letter is valid from March 29, 2020 until the removal or expiration of Texas Governor Abbott's Executive Order (GA-12), issued March 29, 2020. The order mandates that quarantine will not apply to travel related to critical infrastructure functions.
