
Wearing a mask protects others.


When you wear a mask, you protect others. When others wear a mask, they protect you.

As communicated in the July 9th Coronavirus Update from Corporate Affairs, face coverings are now required at all Sasol North American locations. Based on employee questions and feedback, we are providing some additional guidance to ensure consistent understanding and application of the expectations:

1. Face coverings are required indoors in all common areas, and in vehicles and elevators with more than one occupant.
2. Face coverings are not required while an individual is consuming food or drinks, but a distance of six feet apart from any other individual should be maintained during the time period while their mask is removed.
3. Face coverings are not required when working alone in a closed office or in a cubicle if a distance of six feet apart from any other individual can be maintained.
4. Face coverings are not required when working outdoors, in a maintenance area, or in a laboratory if a distance of six feet apart from any other individual can be maintained.
5. Face coverings are not required for any individual giving a speech to an audience. The speaker must maintain a distance of six feet apart from any other individual.
6. Face coverings may be temporarily removed for identification purposes.
7. Cloth face coverings should be washed and reused according to the manufacturer's instructions. Disposable face masks are not considered medical waste and may be discarded in the trash.

Protect yourself and others against infections



Wear your mask in the workplace if and where expected.



Wearing a mask should not provide a false sense of security and be mindful of some considerations regarding the safe and effective wearing of masks.



Make sure your mask fits properly before you start your tasks safely.



Refrain from touching your mask and face. Wash your hands with soap and water if you have done so. Where washing facilities are not available, please use hand sanitiser instead.



When you remove your mask for eating and drinking purposes ensure, over and above hand washing, to follow other control measures such as social distancing, sneeze and cough etiquette and workplace disinfection.



It is important that secondary risks, through improper mask use, disposal and care taking, are avoided. Please follow the cleaning instruction of your cloth mask as provided.



Where single use masks are worn, the instructions on the use and disposal thereof should be followed. Other forms of disposable respiratory PPE should be considered as potentially infected and the same disposal as single use masks applies.
